RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. Name of Event:** Final Selection Trials for Asian games 2026.
- 2. Date:** 08th June 2026.
- 3. Venue:** Indoor Hall, Shree Shiv Chhatrapati Sports Complex, Balewadi, Mahalunge, Pune, Maharashtra.

4. Weight Categories & Number of Players to be Selected:

As per the entry policies of the Asian Games 2026, a total of 4 women players and 3 men players may participate in Kurash events. In the women's section, a maximum of 2 players may participate in each of the 2 weight categories, whereas in the men's section, a maximum of 2 players may participate in one weight category and 1 player in the other weight category.

- 5. Eligibility Criteria:** As per the Asian Games Selection Policy of The Indian Kurash Association, only those Probables who were selected on 11 May & 12 May shall be eligible to participate in the Final Selection Trials.

5. Documentation & Equipment

a) **Mandatory Documents:**

- Original passport.
- Two recent passport-size photos.

b) **Kurash Uniform:** Participants must bring Green and Blue Kurash Yakhtak, as per international standards.

6. Selection Trials Format

a) **General Format:**

A Round Robin format shall be followed. As per Point 8 of Point No. 32 (Order of Holding the Competitions) of the Rules of the International Kurash Association, if there are five or fewer players in a draw, the competition shall be conducted on a round-robin basis, wherein each player will compete against every other player.

b) **Officiating:** Conducted by certified referees and technical officials appointed by the TIKA.

c) **Match Duration:** Men – 4 minute, Women – 3 minute.

d) **Rules:** Matches will be governed strictly as per the International Kurash Association rules.

7. Videography

a) Videography of all matches is mandatory.

b) The Indian Kurash Association will record all matches for official review, transparency, and documentation purposes.

8. Decision Review & Protests

a) If a referee's decision is found incorrect during a match, it is the duty of the Jury Members to correct the decision immediately.

b) If a coach disagrees with the decision, they must submit a formal protest within 15 seconds, along with a protest fee of ₹1000.

c) If the protest is found to be valid after review, the protest fee will be refunded.

9. Additional Terms

- a) The Indian Kurash Association reserves the right to amend or cancel the trials due to unforeseen circumstances.
- b) Submission of false documents, misrepresentation, or breach of discipline will result in immediate disqualification.
- c) The Indian Kurash Association & Selection Committee shall not be held responsible for any injuries, accidents, or medical emergencies during the trials. All participants will compete at their own risk. In the case of minors, parents/guardians are fully responsible for the participation of their wards.
- d) If any other situation arises that is not covered by this policy, it will be resolved by the majority decision of the selection committee.

10. Participation Fee: Participation in the trials shall be completely free of cost.

11. Accommodation & Meals

- a) All participants shall be responsible for their own accommodation. lunch will be provided by the organiser only on 08 June.
- b) The organizing committee can assist by providing contact details of nearby accommodations.

12. Public Transport Access

- a) **Nearest Railway Station:** Pune Junction Railway Station (approx.8 km from venue)
- b) **Nearest Airport:** Pune International Airport (approx. 21 km from venue).
